BOARD RELATIONSHIP WITH BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR:

1. The Board of Education (Board), the Superintendent, and the Business Administrator/Chief Financial Officer (CFO) together form the leadership of the District. The Board governs, the Superintendent administers, and the Business Administrator/CFO conducts the financial management of the District. The leadership will work cooperatively to develop and further the mission, vision, and goals of the District. The Board employs and evaluates the Superintendent and holds that person accountable for District performance and compliance with state and federal statutes. The Board delegates authority to the Superintendent to manage the District and implement the core values, vision, mission, goals, priorities, and policies of the District.
2. Likewise the Board employs and evaluates the Business Administrator/CFO and holds that person accountable for proper and prudent financial management of the District. The Board delegates authority to the Business Administrator/CFO to manage the finances of the District to support the vision, mission, goals, and policies of the District. The Business Administrator/CFO works under the direction of the Superintendent (see U.C.A. §53G-4-303 and §53G-4-304).
