Curriculum implementation decisions will be based upon study and consideration of the following criteria, including, but not limited to:             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3.1. Evidence-based instructional practices aligned with the State and/or the Common Core Standards.</li> <li>3.2. Relevant formative and summative assessments.</li> <li>3.3. New developments in subject matter or competency.</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
