	<i>ASSOCIATED CSD ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION:</i> 500.6-3	<i>APPROVED:</i> 10.15.19
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Elementary Schools:</b> Personal electronic devices and accessories should remain stored, out of sight, and silenced during the school day and on school property. Administrative exceptions may be granted for students with individual education plans (IEPs), 504 accommodations, and individual health plans.</li> <li>2. <b>Middle Schools:</b> Personal electronic devices and accessories should remain stored and out of sight unless directed by the individual teacher. Appropriate uses of personal electronic devices under the direction of the Principal and individual teacher include, but are not limited to: direct instruction and related activities, instruction in technology responsible use, and opportunities for students to enter due dates, assignments, and review schedules.</li> <li>3. <b>High Schools:</b> Personal electronic devices and accessories may be used or restricted under the direction of the Principal and individual teacher.</li> </ol>
